

Alacati Surf Festival – 9-15 July 2007

A beautiful shallow, flat water bay where the air temperature is somewhere between 24 and 32 degrees C, crystal clear waters of 20 to 24, perfect side-shore winds almost guaranteed to be between 15 and 20 knots every afternoon . . . too good to be true?

“After four tremendous competition days the IFCA European Slalom Championships 2005 in Alacati, Cesme (Turkey) ended today. The venue has left an excellent impression on the competitors, the class and the Euro-Cup organization. Every day the wind was blowing with at least 15 knots. The maximums reached up to over 30 knots. This enabled the race committee to run no less than 9 slalom eliminations for all of the fleets.”

“91 competitors from 23 different countries took part in the IFCA Slalom Worlds during August 2006 and experienced perfect wind and spectacular slalom action yet again.”

So good were these events that IFCA is coming back to windsurfing slalom capital of the world - Alacati Beach Resort, Turkey - with the first ever **IFCA Junior, Youth and Masters World Championships** - separate from the Men's and Women's Worlds – from **9th to 15th July 2007** for the **Alacati Surf Festival**.

The Alacati Surf Festival is a tour stop of the **EuroCup Slalom**, counting towards the mens and ladies **European Slalom Championships**. 15.000,00 euro prize money and the great Turkish hospitality will be a perfect base for a great event.

The Alacati Surf Festival will also host the **Slalom Youth and Slalom Masters World Championships**. And introducing, for the first time for Under 17's, the Slalom Junior World Championships – the **“ProKids SLALOM WORLDS”**.

There are some fantastic deals* on offer for junior and youth teams:

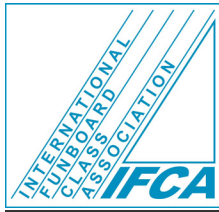
- ◆ National Teams, with a National coach, can pay a one-off fee of 200,00 euro and bring as many Junior and Youth competitors as they like for this fee!
