**1. Rules**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the ISAF 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Class rules, as well as this Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions will apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

**2. Advertising**

- 2.1 Category C will apply.
- 2.2 The Organizing Authority may require competitors to display advertising material.

**3. Entry**

- 3.1. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached entry form and sending it, together with the required fee to Estonian 470 Association before 17<sup>th</sup> September:

- 3.2. Late entries will be accepted under payment of a late entry fee.
- 3.3. Classes for which there is only one entry by 17<sup>th</sup> September will be cancelled, and the entry fees for those classes will be refunded.

## 5. Registration and measurements

5.1 All competitors shall complete on-site registration at the Regatta Office in Pirita harbour.

5.2. Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate, a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.000.000 EEK or the equivalent per event, an ID document in age restricted classes, and medical licence for under 18 years old competitors.

5.3. All sails shall be measured and signed according to the Class Rules.

6.1. There will be no warning signal for any class after 15:30 on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2007.

7 races per class are planned but not more than 4 races per day.

## 7. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available at registration on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2007.

## 8. Venue

The regatta will be sailed on Tallinn Bay.

## 9. The Courses

There will be trapezoid courses.

Course area A will be used for Laser Radial, 420, Laser, Finn, 470, Raceboard Junior and Raceboard.

Course area B will be used for Optimist, Zoom8, Laser 4.7, Techno 293 and Raceboard Youth.

## 10. Scoring

10.1. At least 4 races are required to be completed to constitute the race series.

10.2. a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat`s series score shall be the sum of her race scores.

b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat`s series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10.3 Each class will have an overall ranking list. Each subdivision ranking list will be established by deleting the non-eligible crews from the overall ranking list by not changing the race scores and series scores.

## **11. Prizes**

11.1. Tallinn Week Prizes will be given as follows:

2 competitors = 1 prize

3 competitors = 2 prizes

4 competitors = 3 prizes

16 or more competitors = 25% of the number of competitors but not more than 6 prizes per division.

11.2. Nordic Championship medals in the 470 class will be awarded to the three best crews.

11.3. Estonian Championship medals will be given to 3 best Estonian crews in each subcategory, if there are 4 or more boats racing in this category.
