Day two started with a storm and ended with a storm, and in between there was plenty of drama on the race course, especially for the men's fleet. After a total of five races, Wojtek Brzozowski has been knocked down to fourth and Przemek Miarczyński, also from Poland, now occupies the top spot with Dennis Little NED in second. Aussie Steve Allen took a bullet in race 4 and lies in third place.

A big thunderstorm and lots of rain could not dampen the enthusiasm of delegates and observers to the Annual General Meeting in the evening. By contrast a sunny morning for day three in Santa Pola but the wind did not really materialise - just one race for the women. Marta Hlavaty now has three wins under her belt but she is only two points of Allison Shreeve AUS. Polish Agnieszka Pietrasik won race 5 and is in third place.

The forecast looks promising for tomorrow - we hope to get back on schedule with the race programme.
