



## **2012 Report from the Formula Experience Class to the ISAF Windsurfing & Kiteboarding Committee**

This 2012 report is somewhat brief, mainly due to the fact that this years major championships are scheduled for the year end.

The 2011 World Championship held in Cancun, Mexico from 26<sup>th</sup> December to 1<sup>st</sup> January, was won by the 2010 World Champion – Nicolas Schreier (PER).

This worlds was preceded by the South American Championships hosted by Windsurfing Chile in Algarrabo from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> November.

The 2012 South Americans take place (*took place*) in Salvador-Bahia, Brasil from 11<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> October. South American Champion – Paulo Dos Reis (BRA).

The 2012 World Championships will follow at the end of the year – in Paracas, Peru, from 18<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> December.

The class has maintained its membership during 2011, with fleets continuing to grow in some countries, but the class remains particularly strong in South America (Brazil, Peru, Chile) and Mexico.
