1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing Windsurfing Competition Rules (WCR).
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.
- 1.5 The championship is the African Continental Qualification event for the 2018 Youth Olympic Games for Windsurfer Men & Windsurfer Women –<u>YOG Qualification System</u>. The top ranked male competitor and top ranked female competitor from the first two different <u>African</u> <u>countries</u>, in the Youth (under 19) T293 Plus Championship, shall qualify that country to compete in the Men's Windsurfer and Women's Windsurfer events in the YOG. To qualify a country a competitor shall be born between 1st January 2000 and 31st December 2003

2 ADVERTISING

Boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. World Sailing Regulation 20 'Advertising Code' shall apply.

3 CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

- 3.1 The participating **classes** and divisions shall be:
- 3.1.1 **RS:X** Men, Women, Youth Men, Youth Women;
- 3.1.2 Techno 293 (T293) Junior Boy & Girl, Youth Boy & Girl;
- 3.1.3 Techno 293 Plus (T293 Plus) Youth Men, Youth Women, Men & Women;
- 3.2 Age Divisions:
- 3.2.1 A T293 Junior shall be under 15 years of age on 31st December 2017 (born in 2003 and not later than 2006).
- 3.2.2 A T293 Youth shall be under 17 years of age on 31st December 2017 (born in 2001 and not later than 2004).
- 3.2.3 An RS:X or T293 Plus Youth shall be under 19 years of age on 31st December 2017 (born in 1999 and not later than 2003).
- 3.3 A minimum of 4 competitors is required to constitute a division.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 All entries shall meet the requirements of World Sailing Regulation 19-Eligibility Code.
- 4.2 Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association, which is a paid up member of the relevant international class association; or of either the IWA or RS:X class. Membership formalities can be completed on site.
- 4.3 Eligible competitors may <u>enter online</u> credit/debit card or bank transfer payment required.
 Online entry will close on 22nd November.
- 4.4 A competitor entry is not valid until the entry fee is paid.
- 4.5 The following shall be presented upon registration:
 - Evidence of valid third party insurance
 - Proof of age
 - Parental Permission Form for those under age of 18
- 4.6 Coaches and team support personnel may register online

Payment shall be cash on site.

The following shall be presented at the race office:

- Boat Driving Licence
- Evidence of valid third party insurance

5 FEES

- 5.1 The required entry fee for all classes and divisions is 160 euro.
- 5.2 Competitor entry fees paid by **31**st **October** shall receive a 30-euro discount.
- 5.3 Entries accepted at event registration may incur a late fee of 20 euro.
- 5.4 The fee for coach and support personnel is 30 euro
- 5.5 Entry fees paid at registration shall be in cash euro.

6 RACE FORMAT

- 6.1 The Championships shall be *racing*, "open entry" events.
- 6.2 Men, women, boys and girls, junior and youth, within the **Class** may race together and may be scored separately, depending upon entry numbers.
- 6.3 **Classes** will have separate starts.
- 6.4 A maximum 4 races are scheduled each day for each **Class/division**, in a maximum 12 race series.
- 6.5 Three races are required to validate the championship for each **Class**/division.

8 EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 8.1 An Equipment Registration Form, which will be available at registration, shall be returned to the Event Equipment Inspector by the end of registration.
- 8.2 Equipment inspections may be made at any time during the event.
- 8.3 Unless otherwise directed by the organizing authority, boards and equipment shall be stored, launched and retrieved from the designated area at the event site.

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available at registration. Any changes to the SI's shall be approved by the Class Representative at the event.

10 COURSES

Courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

11 INTERNATIONAL JURY

An International Jury may be appointed according to WCR 91(b). There shall be no appeal against its decisions in accordance with WCR 70.5.

12 SCORING

Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A.

13 COACHES SUPPORT BOATS

13.1 Support boats shall be registered at the race office.

- 13.2 Support boat divers shall have a valid boat licence and a third party liability insurance

14 SAFETY

Every competitor and support boat crewmember shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50).

15 PRIZES

15.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three competitors of each constituted Class /division.

- 15.2 The first man and the first woman (boy/girl) in each **Class** /division will be declared **2017** "**Class**/division...... **African Champion**".
- 15.3 Titles shall only be awarded to competitors eligible to compete for an African national class association World Sailing Nationality Criteria apply.

16 OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organising authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion.

17 RISK STATEMENT

- 17.1 Rule 4 of the RRS states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:
- 17.1.1 They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;

- 17.1.2 They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- 17.1.3 They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- 17.1.4 Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- 17.1.5 The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the race organizer does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- 17.1.6 The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
- 17.1.7 The fact that the Race Committee conducts inspections, or not, of a boat does not reduce the responsibilities of each competitor set out in this Notice of Race.

18 INSURANCE

Each participating boards shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 500,000 euro per event or the equivalent.

19 RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
