1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the <u>Windsurfing Slalom Racing</u> <u>Rules (WSRR)</u>.
- **1.2** No national prescriptions will apply.
- **1.3** If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- **1.4** The International Funboard Class Association (IFCA) Championship Rules shall apply.
- **1.5** For this championship Class Rule C.2.3.(b) shall not apply.
- **1.6** The regatta activities must be carried out in accordance with the provisions on the fight and containment of diffusion of COVID 19 issued by the Italian Federation. The Organizing Committees will activate these provisions and all participants must adhere under the supervision of the Organizing Committee itself. In the case that any cases of COVID 19 will be detected during the event. These will be reported by the Organizing Committee to the competent health authorities in charge.
- 1.7 Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable request from an event official. Failure to comply may be misconduct. Reasonable actions by event officials to implement COVID-19 guidance, protocols or legislation, even if they later prove to have been unnecessary, are not improper actions or omissions. The latest local COVID-19 regulations can be found at <u>Italian COVID information</u> and are part of this NOR

2 ADVERTISING

- **2.1** Sailors may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. World Sailing Regulation 20 'Advertising Code' shall apply.
- **2.2** Event branding shall be worn at all times when afloat, and as requested by the organisers during media interviews and during the prize giving.

3 DIVISIONS

3.1	Age Divisions for prizes, not titles:						
3.2	Youth shall be under the age of 21 (born in or after 2001).						
3.3	Master shall be over the age of 40 (born 1980 or earlier).						
3.4	A Grand Master shall be over the age of 50 (born 1970 or earlier).						
3.5	A minimum of 5 competitors is required to constitute a prize division.						
3.6	This championship is for sailors in the FIN division only - see Class Rule C.6.1.						
4	ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY						
4 4.1	ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY Entries shall meet requirements of World Sailing Regulation 19-Eligibility Code.

5 FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee is: 200 euro, except for Youth 190 euro.
- **5.2** A discount of 40 euro applies for entries received by 15th September 2021.
- **5.3** Late entries accepted at registration will incur a 20 euro surcharge. Entry

6 RACE FORMAT

- **6.1** The Championships shall be a single discipline, *slalom racing*, "open entry" event.
- 6.2 Men and women may race together.
- **6.3** Competitors may race a maximum 4 eliminations per day.
- **6.4** One completed slalom elimination (including both A and B finals) is required to validate a championship.

7 SCHEDULE

7.2 There will be a daily skippers meeting 1 hour before first possible warning signal.

8 EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION 8.1 An <u>Online Equipment Inspection Form</u> shall be completed by each competitor and submitted before the end of registration on Wednesday September 29th. 8.2 Equipment inspections may be made at any time during the event.

- 8.3 Sail Identification Compliance. The Equipment Inspectors will pay attention to sail identification rule. A discretionary penalty of 1 point may be imposed for every slalom elimination sailed with sail numbers that are not complying.
- 8.4 Use of a FOIL is not permitted see Class Rule C.6.1

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available upon registration. Any changes to the SI's shall be approved by the Class Representative.

10 COURSES

Courses will be as described in the IFCA Championship Rules or as prescribed in the sailing instructions or published on the official notice board (ONB).

11 INTERNATIONAL JURY

An International Jury may be appointed in accordance with WSRR Appendix N. There shall be no appeal from their decisions.

12 SCORING

Scoring will be according to the WSRR Appendix A.

13 COACHES & SUPPORT BOATS

Coaches and support boats shall be registered with the organiser. Support boat drivers shall have a valid boat licence and third party liability insurance.

14 SAFETY

If personal buoyancy is prescribed every competitor and support boat crewmember shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard ISO 12402-5 (Level 50).

15 PRIZES & TITLES

15.1 Trophies may be awarded to the first three competitors in each valid division.

- 15.2 The first competitor in the championship ranking for Men shall be declared: **"2021 IFCA Men Slalom European Champion".**
- 15.3 The first competitor in the championship ranking for Women shall be declared: **"2021 IFCA Women Slalom European Champion"**.
- 15.4 There will be a **10,000 euro prize fund**, to be distributed according to IFCA Championship Rules.

16 OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organising authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion. **Prize winners may forfeit prizes for non attendance at the prize giving ceremony.**

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WSRR 4 - Decision to Race. The organising authority or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

18 INSURANCE

Each participating competitor shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,500,000 euro per event or the equivalent.

19 RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use, modify and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
