Race board, RS:One, RS:X, and Techno 293 : No minimum wind strength. Above wind strengths are guidelines. Should wind be insufficient, racing will go ahead to allow results.

PRIZES

Medals will be awarded for the 1st to 3rd placed competitors in each category, where applicable. Product prizes may be awarded subject to the discretion of the Organizing committee.
