#### 1. GENERAL

THE INTERNATIONAL COMMITTE of the "JUEGOS NAUTICOS ATLANTICOS" and the ORGANISING COMMITTE OF THE 2015 ATLANTIC GAMES, cordially invite all regions and countries of the Atlantic Arc, to participate in the XXI edition of the ATLANTIC GAMES. The INTERNATIOL COMMITTE reserves the right to invite other regions and countries.

The 2015 ATLANTIC GAMES will be held from the 13 th to 17 th of July.

The following sea sports will be represented: Rowing, Kayak, Swimming, Surfing, Canoeing, Life Saving, Underwater Sports, Sailing and Disabled Sailing, all of them under the organization of:

- FEDERACION VASCA DE PRIAGÚISMO (FVC)
- FEDERACION VASCA DE REMO (FVR)
- -FEDERACION VASCA DE VELA (FVV)
- -FEDERACION VASCA DE SURG (FVS)
- -FEDERACION VASCA DE NATACION (FVN)
- -FEDRACION VASCA DE SUBACUATICAS

Twovenues will be set up for the competition:

ORIO: Sailing, Swimming, Underwater Sports, Life saving, Canoeing and Rowing.

ZARAUZ: Surfing and Kayak

Opening ceremony will be sagged at Orio and the Closingceremonyin Orio.

#### 2. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The 2015 Atlantic Games are organized by the UNION OF BASQUE SPORTS FEDERATIONS with the collaboration of CLUB DE REMO Y PIRAGUISMO DE ORIO.

#### 4. Sports and Disciplines

#### 5. MATERIAL PROVIDED BY THE ORGANISATION

Competitors shall be penalized for misuse or breakage of any material borrowed from the organization, in those disciplines where the organization should provide the material; this penalization could entail disqualification, payment of compensation or withdrawal from privilege of use of such material, depending on the decision adopted by the Organizing Committee.

The Organizing Committee will not leaned technical material o other personal equipment.















Modifications are not permitted by users to any of the crafts lent, without the written authorization of the Organizing Committee.

#### 6. ELEGIBILITY

#### 6.1 REGONS PARTICIPATING

The 2015 Atlantic Games are open too all competitors from regions of the Atlantic Arc and riverine countries.

The International Committee may take in account the participation of specific clubs, regions o countries out side the Atlantic Arc.

#### 6.2 TEAMS & LICENCES

All the sportsmen/women shall be citizens or members of a club from the country or region, which has been invited to the 2015 Atlantic Games and wherein they are registered, and hold the corresponding sports federation licence or Civil Liability insurance policy pertaining to each country or region. In the event of eligibility problems, the International Committee will decide on the problem, and its decision will be final.

#### 6.3 TEAM FLAGS

Each team is obliged to bring a national o regional flag of approximately 1,5 x 2,5 m. and a CD/MP3 with its national or regional anthem.

#### 7. REGISTRATION

#### 7.1 PRE-REGISTRATION

The countries or regions must inform the Organization Committee, from the 1<sup>st</sup>. of March up to the 15<sup>th</sup>. of April, of the final number of their participants; in the form of a Pre-registration:

- The total number escorts with each team

#### 7.2 SPORTSMEN & WOMEN REGISTRATION

The registrations shall be made from **15<sup>th</sup>.of April 2015** onwards, using the 2015 Atlantic Games web page, by the national o regional authorities of the participants that have been invited to the 2015 Atlantic Games; and must be received by the International Committee before the **14<sup>th</sup>.of June 2015**, the fee shall be **40,00€/per person & sport.** 

Any competitor registered after the **14<sup>th</sup>.of June 2015** up until the **26<sup>th</sup>.of June 2015** shall pay **70,00€/per person & sport.** 

Any registration not paid or confirmed by 5:00 pm on the  $26^{th}$  of June shall be cancelled. Registration ends at 12:00 pm on the  $26^{th}$  of June.

Any competitor entered in more then one sport must pay as many registration fees as sports in which he or she participates.

Any competitor that participates in more than one discipline of the same sport shall only pay one registration.

#### **12. POINTS ALOCATION**

The point allocation for each sport shall be valid when a minimum of three countries o regions participates.

Each of the sports committees shall lay down the points system to be applied in their venues.

#### **13. SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS**

Specific instructions for each of the sports shall be made available to each of the participants as soon as they have formalized their registration at their corresponding venue.

#### **14. INTERNATIONAL JURY**

International Juries will be formed for each of the disciplines, designated by the Organizing Committee and sanctioned by the International Committee.

#### **15. ANTIDOPING**

Test controls may be carried out.

#### **16. MEASUREMENTS**

Measurements controls shall be carried out at the beginning and during all events on competition days.















#### **17. RESPONSIBILITY**

Those participating in these Games do so under their own risk and responsibility. The Organizing Committee or any person or body involved in the organization of the event, reject any responsibility for: loss, damage, injuries, death or discomfort suffered by people or things, both on land and at sea, as a consequence of the participation in the games covered by this Announcement.

All competitors are exclusively responsible for deciding whether to participate in a competition or whether to continue with the same.

The Organizing Committee may require payment for damages arising from misuse of the nautical facilities and the accommodation premises. A participant may be expelled due to miss conduct or bad behaviour, aside from the actions that the respective Jury may undertake.
