Discipline information for the Rollei Summer Opening / IFCA Slalom Worlds

The Rollei Summer Opening is a 3-Discipline-Event: Slalom (IFCA Slalom Worlds), Racing (Formula Windsurfing in the German Windsurf Cup) and Wave (German Windsurf Cup). We have received some requests from national as well as international competitors referring to this issue which we would like to clarify herewith.

Eligibility:

All riders may participate in all disciplines. This means that German competitors are also entitled to participate in the IFCA Slalom Worlds. Vice versa international riders are entitled to register for Racing and Wave.

Registration and entry fee:

For the registration you need to be aware that there are two different registration systems for this regatta. As for all international class championships the registration for the IFCA Slalom Worlds is handled by the International Windsurfing Association (IWA). There is an online registration system provided for this purpose (<https://adobeformscentral.com/?f=t2aRnubSziP-vIGgWtefmA#>). Accordingly the entry fee for this discipline needs to be paid to the IWA.

For the disciplines Racing and Wave the registration is possible via the official website www.windsurfcup.de as for all German windsurf cups (<http://windsurfcup.de/registration/>). The entry fee for these disciplines need to be paid to the entry fee account of the German windsurf cup. But Attention! Riders who have registered for the IFCA Slalom Worlds have a free-of-charge-entry for the other disciplines of the regatta. So they don't face any additional costs if they want to participate in the additional disciplines. Nonetheless we kindly request all riders to make their registration via the website or by informing us by E-Mail so the we are able to plan accordingly.

So just for clarification: The regular entry fee for the German windsurf cup only needs to be paid by riders who want to participate in the disciplines Racing and/or Wave AND NOT in the IFCA Slalom Worlds.

Race organisation:

The discipline Slalom has the priority as it is the official world championship discipline. Racing (Formula Windsurfing) is the light wind alternative and will mostly be run when the conditions are not sufficient for the discipline Slalom. Wave is the high wind alternative and will mostly be an option when the conditions are too radical (wind speed, waves, current etc.) for the discipline Slalom.

But even if Slalom has the priority, it is the goal for the race committee to achieve results in all the disciplines of the event if the conditions allow it. This is not a new situation for the German windsurf cup. It is the regular praxis since several years at the events on Sylt. And in many cases it was possible to run all disciplines.

If you want to have a lot of water time you should register for all three disciplines and bring all your gear.

Scoring:

During the regatta there are only "competitors". There is no difference between German competitors and riders from foreign countries. For the German riders competing in the German windsurf cup it is important to know that all foreigners will be discarded from the results and the German riders move up before the results are included in the ranking list.

All disciplines are scored individually. In the discipline Slalom the official World Championship title will be awarded and on top an prize money of 15.000,- Euro will be paid out.

Additionally the event will score an overall result. This is based on the addition of the two best disciplines of every competitor. The third discipline is a discard.
