1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing Windsurfing Competition Rules (WCR).
- 1.2 The International Formula Windsurfing Class (IFWC) Championship Rules shall apply.
- 1.3 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Sailors may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. ISAF Regulation 20 'Advertising Code' shall apply.
- 2.2 Event branding shall be worn at all times when afloat, and as requested by the organizers during media interviews and during the prize giving.

3 DIVISIONS

- 3.1 **Gender Division:** Men and Women.
- 3.2 **Age Divisions**: Youth and Masters:
- 3.2.1 A Youth shall be under the age of 20 (born in or after 1998, not later than 2003).
- 3.2.2 A Master shall be a man over the age of 35 (born 1981 or earlier).
- 3.3 Age sub-divisions:
- 3.3.1 A Junior shall be under the age of 17 (born in or after 2001, not later than 2003).
- 3.3.2 A Grand Master shall be a man over the age of 45 (born 1971 or earlier).
- 3.3.3 A Veteran shall be a man over the age of 55 (born 1961 or earlier).
- 3.4 A minimum of 5 competitors is required to constitute a division or sub division.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 All entries shall meet the requirements of ISAF Regulation 19 Eligibility Code.
- 4.2 Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association which is a paid up member of the relevant international class association, or of the IWA. Membership formalities can be completed on site.
- 4.3 The following shall be presented upon registration:
 - Evidence of valid third party insurance
 - Proof of age
 - Emergency Contact and Health Information Form for those under age of 18

5 FEES

- 5.1 The required entry fee: is 80 euro; except Youth entry fee is 50 euro.
- 5.2 Entry fees paid at registration shall be paid in cash (euro).

6 RACE FORMAT

- 6.1 The Formula Festival shall be a *racing*, "open entry", event.
- 6.2 All competitors will race together.
- 6.3 Competitors shall race a maximum 5 races per day, in a maximum 15 race series.
- 6.4 Three races is required to validate the event.

7.2 There may be a daily skippers meeting on racing days at one hour before the scheduled time for racing.

8 EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 8.1 An Equipment Inspection Form, which will be available at registration, shall be returned to the Event Equipment Inspector by the close of registration.
- 8.2 Equipment inspections may be made at any time during the event.
- 8.3 Unless otherwise directed by the organising authority, boards and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from the designated area at the event site.

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available upon registration and published on the event website. Any changes to the SI's shall be approved by the Class Representative at the event.

10 COURSES

Courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

11 INTERNATIONAL JURY

An International Jury may be appointed. The decisions of the International Jury shall be final in accordance with Appendix N and RRS 70.5.

12 SCORING

Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A, except for discards which shall be according to IFWC Championship Rules.

13 COACHES & SUPPORT BOATS

Coaches and support boats shall be registered with the organiser. Support boat drivers shall have a valid boat licence and third party liability insurance.

14 SAFETY

Support boat crewmember, and, if conditions require it, competitors, shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50). Personal buoyancy is mandatory for all competitors under 17 years of age.

STANDARD NOTICE OF RACE INTERNATIONAL EVENTS

15 PRIZES

- 15.1 Prizes may be awarded to the first three competitors of each properly constituted division or sub division.
- 15.2 The first Man will be declared "2017 Hellenic National Cup Champion"
- 15.3 The first Youth will be declared "2017 Hellenic National Cup Youth Champion"
- 15.4 The first Master will be declared "2076 Hellenic National Cup Master Champion"
- 15.5 The first Woman will be declared "2017 Hellenic National Cup Woman Champion"
- 15.6 The first junior will be declared "2017 Hellenic National Cup Junior Champion".
- 15.7 Prizes will be awarded for the Overall Open Cup

16 OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organising authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion. **Prize winners may forfeit prizes for non attendance at the prize giving ceremony.**

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WCR 4 - Decision to Race. The organising authority or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

18 INSURANCE

Each participating competitor/support boat driver shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 300,000 euro per event or the equivalent.

19 RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

Competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.
