#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the ISAF Windsurfing Competition Rules (WCR).
- 1.2 The International Funboard Class Association (IFCA) Championship Rules shall apply.
- 1.3 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

#### 2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Sailors may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. ISAF Regulation 20 'Advertising Code' shall apply.
- 2.2 Event branding shall be worn at all times when afloat, and as requested by the organisers during media interviews and during the prize giving.

#### 3 DIVISIONS

- 3.1 **Age Divisions**:
- 3.1.1 A Junior shall be under the age of 17- born in or after 1995.
- 3.1.2 A Youth shall be under the age 20 born in or after 1992.
- 3.2 A minimum of 3 competitors is required to constitute a division.

#### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 All entries shall meet the requirements of ISAF Regulation 19 Eligibility Code.
- 4.2 Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association which is a paid up member of the relevant international class association, or of the IWA. Membership formalities can be completed on site.

- 4.4 The following shall be presented upon registration:
  - Original Entry Form pre-entries will be given their completed form 1 to check and sign at registration.
  - Evidence of valid third party insurance
  - Proof of age
  - Parental/legal Guardian Assent for those under age of 18
  - <u>Medical Treatment Permission</u> for those under age of 18 or on their parents medical insurance policy

#### 5 FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee is: Youth-150 euro; Junior-120 euro.
- 5.2 A discount of 20 euro applies for entries received by 15 July 2011.
- 5.3 Entry fees paid at registration shall be paid in cash (US \$).
- 5.4 For national <u>iunior</u> teams, recognized by their National Federations, accompanied by a coach, the entry fee will be € 50 for each athlete with a maximum of € 250 for each team provided they are booked and paid for (before 15 July) in one transaction by the coach or national federation through the <u>IWA office</u> (places may be reserved even if competitor names are not confirmed). Each team will be composed of a maximum

of 8 athletes and a minimum of 4. If a team is composed of less than 4 athletes, the entry fee will be € 60 for each athlete.

#### 6 EVENT FORMAT

- 6.1 The championship shall be a single discipline, wave-expression, "open entry" event.
- 6.2 Youth men and women, boys and girls, may compete together.
- 6.3 Competitors shall compete in maximum 3 eliminations per day per division.
- 6.4 One completed elimination is required to validate the event in each division.

- 7.3 The first possible warning signal will be made each day at 1100hrs.
- 7.4 A skippers meeting will be held each day one hour before the scheduled start of competition.

#### 8 EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 8.1 An Equipment Inspection Form, which will be available at registration, shall be returned to the Event Equipment Inspector before the start of competition.
- 8.2 Equipment inspections may be made at any time during the event.

#### 9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available upon registration. Any changes to the SI's shall be approved by the Event's Class Supervisor.

#### 10 COMPETITION AREA

The competition area will be as prescribed in the sailing instructions or as described at the Skippers Meeting.

#### 11 PROTEST COMMITTEE

A Protest Committee will be appointed in accordance with WCR 91(a).

#### 12 SCORING

Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A, and using IFCA Championship Rule # 6.1.

#### 13 COACHES & SUPPORT PERSONNEL

Coaches and support personnel shall be registered with the organiser.

#### 14 SAFETY

Competitors agree to follow the safety code published with the SI's.

#### 15 PRIZES

- 15.1 Prizes may be awarded to the first three competitors of each properly constituted division. Properly constituted divisions will be posted on the official notice board after the completion of the registration.
- 15.2 The first Junior boy or girl will be declared "2011 IFCA Junior Wave World Champion".
- 15.3 The first Youth man or woman will be declared "2011 IFCA Youth Wave World Champion".

#### 16 OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organising authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion. **Prize winners may forfeit prizes for non attendance at the prize giving ceremony.** 

#### 17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WCR 4 - Decision to Race (Compete). The organising authority or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

#### 18 INSURANCE

Each participating competitor/support boat driver shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,000,000 euro per event or the equivalent.

#### 19 RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
