#### Notice of Race

#### 1. EVENT & RULES

- 1.1 The IX Bay of Cadiz New Year Regatta, "IV Kim Lythgoe Memorial Race", for the following Classes: Optimist, RS:X M, W & Youth (8.5) and Techno 293 O.D boys and girls (Under 15 and Under 17) will be held from 27th >31th December 2012. This regatta is a Grade 3 ISAF for the RS:X M and W.
- 1.2 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012, including Appendix B "Windsurfing Competition Rules".
- 1.3 English is the official language of the Race.
- 1.4. Personal buoyancy is compulsory for all competitors, coaches and support boat crew member. The personal flotation device shall be worn above the waist and this will comply with the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (Level 50). This is a legal requirement under Spanish law.

#### 2. ORGANISER

2.1 The Race will be organized by The Andalusian Sailing Federation with the sponsorship of the "Consejería de Turismo Comercio y Deportes de la Junta de Andalucía" and the "Instituto para el Fomento del Deportes de la Diputación Provincial de Cádiz".

#### 3. VENUE

3.1 The venue of the race is "Puerto Sherry" in El Puerto de Santa Maria which is located about 2 hours by car from Seville and 30 minutes from Jerez Airport by car.

#### 4. ENTRIES

- 4.1 All the competitors must contact with Deborah Powell at <u>deborahp@telefonica.net</u>, before 1st December to confirm their participation.
- 4.2 Competitors shall possess valid third party liability insurance to the value of € 300.000.
- 4.3 The entries fees are 30€ per competitor

The entry fees will be paid at the moment of the registration in the Race Office.

#### 5. CLASSES & DIVISION. ELEGIBILITY

- 5.1 Optimist
- 5.2 RS:X men & women
- 5.3 RS:X Youth 8.5 with sails 8.5m2 and 60 cm fin .
- 5.4 Techno 293 O.D. in the following Divisions
- Techno 293 OD under 15 (boys and girls) years old with sails up to 6.8 m2 (Born in 1998 and after)
- Techno 293 OD under 17 (boys and girls) years old with sails up to 7.8 m2 (Born in 1996 and 1997)
- 5.5 The IX Bay of Cadiz New Year Regatta, "IV Kim Lythgoe Memorial Race", for the following Classes: Optimist, RS:X M, W & Youth (8.5) and Techno 293 O.D boys and girls is an "open" event.

- 5.6 RS:X Youth sailors shall be under the age of 19 years on 31 December 2012.
- 5.7 The boards shall race separately from the Optimist Class.
