Notice of Race

1. EVENT & RULES

1.1 The XIII Bay of Cadiz - New Year Regatta, “VIII Kim Lythgoe Memorial Race”, for the following Classes: RS:X M, W & Youth (8.5), Laser St Men, Laser Radial M/W, Raceboard, Laser 4.7 B/G and Techno 293 O.D boys and girls (Under 15 and Under 17) will be held from 27 >31 December 2016.

1.2 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, including Appendix B "Windsurfing Competition Rules".

1.3 English is the official language of the Race.

1.4 Personal buoyancy is compulsory for all competitors, coaches and support boat crew member. The personal flotation device shall be worn above the waist and this will comply with the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (Level 50). This is a legal requirement under Spanish law.

2. ORGANISER

2.1 The Race will be organized by The Andalusian Sailing Federation with the sponsorship of the “Consejería de Turismo y Deportes de la Junta de Andalucía” and the “Instituto para el Fomento del Deporte de la Diputación Provincial de Cádiz”.

3. VENUE

3.1 The venue of the race is “Puerto Sherry” in El Puerto de Santa Maria which is located about 2 hours by car from Seville and 30 minutes from Jerez Airport by car.

4. ENTRIES

4.2 The entry fees are:

- Early Entry Fees (before 10 December 2016): €50 per sailor/coach.
- Later than 10 December 2016: €70 per sailor/coach.

4.3 Competitors shall possess valid third party liability insurance to the value of €300,000.

5.8 The XIII Bay of Cadiz - New Year Regatta, "VIII Kim Lythgoe Memorial Race" is an "open" event.

5.9 RS:X Youth sailors shall be under the age of 19 years on 31 December 2016.

5.10 At least 10 starter boats in each race are required to constitute a valid Class or Division

8.1 The prizes list will be posted on the Official Notice Board before the start of the 1st race.
