#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing Windsurfing Competition Rules (WCR).
- 1.2 The RS:One Championship Rules shall apply.
- 1.3 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

#### 2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Sailors may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. ISAF Regulation 20 'Advertising Code' shall apply.
- 2.2 Event branding shall be worn at all times when afloat, and as requested by the organizers during media interviews and during the prize giving.

#### 3 DIVISIONS

- 3.1 **Gender Divisions:** Men and Women.
- 3.2 Age Divisions:
- 3.2.1 An "Espoir" shall be under the age of 22 in the year of competition (born in or after 1992).
- 3.2.2 A "Master" shall be over the age of 40 in the year of competition (born 1972 or earlier).
- 3.3 A minimum of 5 competitors is required to constitute a division.

#### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 All entries shall meet the requirements of ISAF Regulation 19-Eligibility Code.
- 4.2 Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association which is a paid up member of the international class association, or of the IWA.
- 4.3 Eligible competitors may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, with the entry fee, to: Windsurfing Association Singapore, c/o Constant Wind Pte Ltd, 11 Changi Coast Walk, Singapore, 499740.

The following shall be presented upon registration:

- Original Entry Form
- Evidence of valid third party insurance
- Proof of age
- Parental/legal Guardian Assent for those under age of 18
- <u>Medical Treatment Permission</u> for those under age of 18 or on their parents medical insurance policy
- 4.4 Coaches and team support personnel may enter by completing the attached form and sending it to: *Windsurfing Association Singapore, c/o Constant Wind Pte Ltd, 11 Changi Coast Walk, Singapore, 499740*.

The following shall be presented upon registration:

- Original Coach Entry Form
- Boat Driving Licence (if applicable)
- Evidence of valid third party insurance

#### 5 FEES

- 5.1 The required entry fee is 120 SGD.
- 5.2 Late entries received after 15<sup>th</sup> December 2012 will be surcharged 30 SGD.
- 5.3 Entry fees paid at registration shall be paid in cheque or cash (SGD).
- 5.4 Entry Fee including charter of equipment shall be 220 SGD.

#### 6 RACE FORMAT

- 6.1 The Championship shall be a single discipline, course racing, "open entry" event.
- 6.2 Men and women may race together.
- 6.3 Three races are required to validate the Championship.

7.2 The first possible warning signal will be made each day at 1100hrs, except the last day when the warning signal will be displayed at 1000hrs.

#### 8 EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 8.1 An Equipment Inspection Form, which will be available at registration, shall be returned to the Event Equipment Inspector by the end of registration.
- 8.2 Equipment inspections may be made at any time during the event.
- 8.3 Unless otherwise directed by the organising authority, boards and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from the designated area at the event site.

#### 9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI) will be available upon registration. Any changes to the SI shall be approved by the Class Representative at the event.

#### 10 COURSES

Courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

#### 11 PROTEST COMMITTEE

A Protest Committee will be appointed in accordance with WCR 91(a).

#### 12 SCORING

Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A, but there will be no discards.

#### 13 PRIZES

- 13.1 Prizes may be awarded to the first three competitors of each properly constituted division.
- 13.2 The first man and woman will be declared "2013 RS:One ( division) Asian Champion".

#### 14 OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organising authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion. **Prize winners may forfeit prizes for non attendance at the prize giving ceremony.** 

#### 15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WCR 4 - Decision to Race. The organising authority or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

#### 16 INSURANCE

Each participating competitor/support boat driver shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 300,000 SGD per event.

#### 17 RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
