Traveling & Accommodation Info

1. SLEEPING & ACCOMMODATION

There are different options available.

- 3.1 The organizer provides a competitor camp. Competitors have a special permission to sleep in this area in their cars during the nights free of any charge. Showers and toilettes are provided at the event area. The distance from the competitor camp to the event venue is about 1km. During the day the participants may park their cars on the "Brandenburger Platz". But during the night it is absolutely forbidden to park on this place with vehicles, which has the option to sleep in. This will be enforced by guards.
- 3.2 It is strongly recommended to book apartments or hotel rooms. Westerland offers many hotels and apartments in different price ranges.

2. EQUIPMENT STORAGE & PARKING

- 2.1 There is an equipment storage area directly at the beach in which the participants can drop off their equipment for the event. During the nights (21:00 until 9:00) guards will watch the area.
- 2.2 Attention! Access to the event area with vehicles is strictly forbidden. The only exception is the access for the drop off of the equipment during the build up days (May 6th & 7th). On these days cars may drive up once but have to leave immediately after unloading the gear. Parking on the promenade while rigging is absolutely forbidden. On the departure day (May 12th) a shuttle service will be organized, which brings the equipment from the equipment storage area to the Brandenburger Platz.
- 2.3 During the days, the cars of the participants may be parked on the "Brandenburger Platz". Attention! It is strictly forbidden to sleep at the Brandenburger Platz. A separate competitor camp is provided by the organizer.
- 2.4 Every offence may result in a monetary penalty of 100,- € or a disqualification of the regatta.

3. TRAVELLING

Sylt can be reached by plane, by train, by ship and by car.

1.1 Travelling by plane:

The airport Sylt is located only 3km from the event site. Sylt has numerous direct connections to airports in Germany and many more indirect connections to airports in Germany and foreign countries.

Direct flights to Sylt from: Berlin (Tegel), Düsseldorf, Hamburg, Frankfurt/Main, Köln/Bonn, Munich, Stuttgart Airlines: Lufthansa (sport luggage until 50kg, check: www.lufthansa.com) and Air Berlin (sport luggage until 32kg, check: www.airberlin.com)

The alternative is to fly to Hamburg airport and from there take a rental car. Then follow the guidelines for car traveling.

1.2 Travelling by train:

You can also travel to Sylt by train. The railway station Westerland/Sylt is located only 2km from the event site.

1.3 Travelling by ship:

You can even arrive to Sylt by ship. Harbours can be found in List and Hörnum. There is no harbour directly in Westerland where the event takes place.

1.4 Travelling by car

Most people arrive to Sylt by car. This is also what we would advise for the participants of the event. This way you can easily transport all your gear. But there is one important fact to consider: You cannot drive directly to the island. You need to take either the ferry via Denmark to List harbour or otherwise the AutoZug SyltShuttle which brings you from the terminal in Niebüll on the mainland directly to Westerland.

The AutoZug Syltshuttle is partner of the event. All participants are granted special prices.

How to drive:

From Hamburg you have to drive towards Flensburg (A7). Take the last exit before the border to Denmark (Flensburg/Harrislee). Follow the traffic signs towards Niebüll. There you can use the DB AutoZug SyltShuttle to Westerland/Sylt.

All competitors of the Rollei Summer Opening 2013 get a special price for the car. **Attention!** To get the special price, you have to register for the event until April 10th. All competitors who have registered until this deadline

may apply for an individual code number which enables the discounted price at the ticket counter of DB AutoZug SyltShuttle. These Codes are individual and can't be transferred. The codes will be send per E-Mail. A refund or exchange of tickets isn't possible. Lost or misplaced tickets will not be replaced. For the exact departure times , please check www.sylt-shuttle.de.
