The Techno 293 Class has enjoyed another great year of activity.

Membership The formal membership of the class has increased to 36 nations, representing 6 continents. However, 44 countries participated in the 6 continental championships held by the class; some nations with active fleets did not participate (eg CHN & AUS) and in other countries the fleets are relatively recently established and the focus is not yet upon international competition. The class is therefore active in nearly 70 countries

World Championships. The most successful worlds ever was held this year in Brest, Brittany, France, from 19th to 26th July. A truly memorable and well organised event for **400 techno competitors.**
